



Few motoring emblems have inspired such widespread respect and affection as has the famous octagonal MG badge. This important addition to MG literature concentrates on the V8-engined models — the MGB GT V8 introduced in 1973 and the widely-heralded limitededition RV8 unveiled at the October 1992 Birmingham Motor Show.

Starting with a look at the origins and early development of MG, David Knowles then describes in painstaking detail the advent and subsequent history of the MGB and MGC, the full story of the MGB GT V8 and the revival of the MG name by the Rover Company, which has delighted enthusiasts across the world. Throughout these chapters there are numerous illuminating stories from those who designed and engineered the cars (many of which reveal hitherto undisclosed truths), together with penetrating insights into how and why the decisions were made which led to their creation and into the economic and legislative circumstances which played such a strong part in shaping their destiny.

Those seeking practical guidance will find expert advice on buying and maintaining an MG V8 and converting a standard MGB to V8 power, while facts-and-figures devotees will benefit from a wealth of information on specifications, colour and trim schemes, performance figures, pre-production and development cars, production changes, press cars, police cars, comparisons with rivals, company literature, specialist V8 services and suppliers, and MG clubs.
