LADIES FIRST - 1956

20 Minute

Five MGA Coupes competed in the 1956 Alpine Rally, with Nancy Mitchell taking the ladies prize and becoming only the second Englishwoman to win a Coupe Des Alpes.

MG DOES IT AGAIN-1957

10 Minute

The story of the successful record breaking attempt by Stirling Moss in MG EX181 on the Bonneville Salt Flats, Utah. He broke five International Class F records with an average two-way top speed of 245.64mph.

SPORTSCAR OF THE YEAR - 1958

10 Minut

The launch film of the MGA Twin Cam, tracing its development from the EX182 prototype at the 1955 Le Mans, through to final test and proving runs at MIRA.

MAGIC CARPET - 1962

10 Minut

The launch film of the MG 1100, this film was intended primarily for the American market, showing a young couple test driving their new LHD MG 1100 on a visit to England. The film includes a trip to the Goodwood Motor Racing circuit where the car is tested by Graham Hill.
